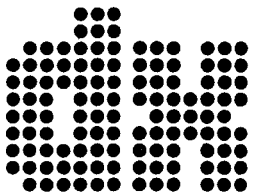

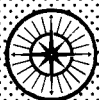

**ASCENSION ISLAND:** Re: "6180 kHz, Mon March 30 at 05.19 UT, sped-up dialog in African language, S=9+10/20dB. HFCC shows BBC Hausa daily except Sundays. Brasil would not be on at this hour, but watch out: not in HFCC.org. HFCC shows this is by ENC ENC Encompass, does not name either BBC or Global Talk America as original source. EiBi.database list does show Global Talk America; missing from Aoki.Nagoya list. (Glenn Hauser-OK-USA, wor April 3)

Re: "6180 kHz: "Good morning Glenn, as always, I am very thankful for your efforts to keep the stream of news on international radio flowing. Please don't mind a comment on one of your items. We were both listening to 6180 kHz on Monday, but it was not the BBC but GTA which was reported by you/in World of Radio to be produced by former VoA employees:

**AUSTRALIA:** 4TRP 2355 kHz - again with very decent reception on March 24. Something is really happening with 4TRP! Outstanding propagation or what? Now, from 1500+ UTC on March 24 (Tuesday), I am again having no problem hearing the low powered station on 2355 kHz, with pop songs and nice IDs. Amazing to hear this, as I often checked for this station in past months with no result at all via the Townsville, Queensland-AUS Kiwi SDR remote. I now have heard the station yesterday from 1702 to past 2000+ UT, with a fairly steady reception. Today it is also with very decent reception.

Outstanding for such a low powered station !Also with fairly decent reception today via the Kiwi SDR remote in SoEaAustralia, at Strathbogie, Victoria.

**BENIN (tent):** 1476 kHz Trans World Africa, via MW Parakou - in Hausa (?), March 6 at 0420 UT. A significant carrier, prolonged fading, poor audio. A male voice was heard, probably the end of a Christian message, music, sign-off at 0430UT (consisting with information from MW-List, 'sign-off at 0430'). S=2.

The previous reception of this station in Sao Bernardo SP Brazil, took place on August 27, 2025 at 0402 UT, with SINPO 13421 (I=3 due to Brazilian a several stations was operating on 1480 kHz in 2025. For some weeks now (in 2026), the presence of 'strong' Brazilian stations on 1480 kHz has not been observed, which facilitated the reception of Trans World Radio, via Benin relay).

**CHINA: Nei Menggu** Chinese News and General Radio extended the schedule.

Nei Menggu (Inner Mongolia Radio & Television Station) have started the integration works of their "News Radio" (Hohhoto 95.0 MHz and others) and "Chinese News and General Radio" (Hohhoto 89.0 MHz MW 675 kHz SW 7420 kHz 9520 kHz and others), to stop "News Radio" in the nearest future.

Therefore, the opening hour of "Chinese News and General Radio" was moved up about 1 hour earlier. Now the transmitting hour is 2100 UT (former 2150-) 1605 UT. They now relay "Voice of China" (CNR1) at 2200-2230 UT, this will be extended to 2200-2300 UT soon.

**Firedrake** jamming to jam 'Sound of Hope' from Taiwan.

SWL André from South Africa, writes about his YouTube video of March 30th "**China's infamous Firedrake**": The shortwave jammer appears to be back on the air. I heard it tonight, 30 March 2026, for the first time in about a year. In this video, I tune to 7280 kHz and 15740 kHz, where you can clearly hear the distinctive Chinese orchestral music à the signature of the so-called Firedrake jammer. I am using the Qodosen DX-286 paired with the MLA30+ loop

antenna, right here in Johannesburg, South Africa.

For those unfamiliar, the Firedrake jammer is part of China's long-running shortwave jamming system. It works by transmitting powerful signals directly on top of target broadcasts, effectively drowning them out.

What makes Firedrake unique is its audio: it plays looping Chinese classical folk music ù often a full hour-long sequence ù specifically designed to block stations while sounding like a legitimate broadcast.

One of its primary targets has long been Sound of Hope, a broadcaster linked to anti-government messaging, along with other international services like Voice of America and Radio Free Asia.

The jammer is believed to be distributed via Chinese satellite feeds and then retransmitted by high-power transmitters across the country, allowing it to appear simultaneously on multiple frequencies ù exactly what we're seeing again here. What's particularly interesting is that Firedrake activity has been sporadic in recent years, with many DXers reporting long periods of silence ù which makes this apparent return all the more significant.

If you've been missing that unmistakable "music jammer" sound on the bands, it looks like it might be back. Frequencies logged in this video:

**CZECH REPUBLIC:** The public **Czech Radio** will get a quarter less than last year's 26.25 million crowns contribution from the Foreign Ministry for its foreign broadcast Radio Prague International this year under an addendum to the contract that its director general Rene Zavoral signed today, he told the Czech Radio Council.

It still needs to be signed by Foreign Minister Petr Macinka (Motorists).

"It will mean a significant reduction in services and a reduction in the number jobs in the foreign broadcasting, which celebrates 90 years this year," Zavoral told the council. He did not want to mention specific austerity measures before discussing them with the foreign broadcasting staff.

The foreign minister announced his intention to cut the foreign broadcasting subsidy a few weeks ago. Next year, he would like to abolish the foreign radio broadcasts altogether as unnecessary. This will require a change in the law.

Radio Prague International broadcasts via the Internet, shortwave or satellite and can currently be tuned in seven languages: English, German, French, Spanish, Ukrainian, Russian and Czech for compatriots abroad. - (\$1 equals 21.315 crowns)

I notice MWList is now showing the Tripolis 1305 kHz outlet as 'also' carrying the **ERA** Zeppelin feed, 1305-0500 UT (& ex-ERA Proto Programma). Evidently, sometimes lighting a fire under the right spot can still get desired results ! Concurrently the Saratov SDR is back online with a very shaky interconnection; checking the 1305 kHz signal there has thusfar proven impossible this evening (or perhaps I lack the patience to pursue).

In my head, I will accept the Tripolis / Zeppelin explanation as factual.

The ERT from Greece is active again on Athens 729 kHz. However, I have the impression that the power is much lower than the 100 kW listed on MW List.orgdatabase. I remember that its absence on the channel had left room for Radio Kano from Nigeria WeAF (and also Cape Pulpit from South Africa).

I also confirm on 945 and 1287 kHz the reactivation of '**Galei Zahal**', the Israeli army radio station, whose closure had been scheduled by the government for March 1, 2026. ### **INDONESIA: Re: RRI and VOI Indonesia ?**

It is a frustrating time for Indonesian shortwave listeners. Reports from the DX community and monitoring logs indicate that several major RRI (Radio Republik Indonesia) and Voice of Indonesia (VOI) shortwave transmitters have indeed been silent or highly irregular over the last several days. Here is the current situation based on technical reports and regional status updates: Status of Frequencies (March 2026)

7203 kHz **RRI Pro 3** Silent. This transmitter (Palangkaraya) has been experiencing intermittent power supply and cooling system issues.

3325 kHz **VOI / Pro 4** Inactive. Historically a 50 kW signal from Palangkaraya, it has been off-air for an extended period due to hardware failure

4755 kHz **VOI / Pro 4** Unstable. This 10kW signal from Cimanggis (We Java) often goes silent due to maintenance on the aging transmitter.

9690 kHz **VOI** Inactive. Currently listed as out of service in the latest B25 broadcast schedules.

Why is this happening?

Transition to DRM (Digital Radio Mondiale): RRI is currently in the middle of a massive push toward digital radio. Indonesia is hosting the DRM General Assembly in May 2026, and resources are being redirected toward upgrading sites to digital-capable transmitters. This often leaves the older analog shortwave hardware neglected.

Maintenance Backlogs: The transmitters at the Cimanggis and Palangkaraya sites are notorious for "parts fatigue". Since shortwave is no longer the primary focus for domestic delivery (replaced by FM and the RRI Digital app), repairs are often slow.

Frequency Reallocation: There has been some movement of services to satellite (Telkom-4) and online streaming, leading to a "managed decline" of the shortwave infrastructure.

**IRAN/ISRAEL:** The Israeli Defence Forces (IDF) says it destroyed the headquarters of Iran's state broadcaster IRIB in an airstrike in Tehran a short while ago.

The Islamic Republic of Iran Broadcasting (IRIB) building had already been targeted by Israel during the June 2025 war. Israeli Air Force fighter jets dropped dozens of bombs on the building a short while ago, destroying it, the military says.

According to the military, the "Iranian terrorist regime's communications center" was used to "advance military activities under the guise of civilian activity and assets, in addition to the propaganda activities that emanate from the communications center."

### **Savings and budget restrictions mandatory.**

As announced at the end of 2023, NHK Radio 2 ceased broadcasting on 29 March. This was in line with the management plan for the 2024-2026 financial years.

Most of the programs of R2 will be transferred to "NHK AM"(former R1) and "NHK FM" after March 30, except; Arabic Lesson, News in Thai / Chinese / Korean / Vietnamese (to online only), Stock Market Reports, "Easy Japanese"(to NHK World Radio Japan ) and other 4 programs.

The transmission licenses of all R2 stations (including 4 x 500 kW sites - Shobu (Tokyo) 693 kHz, Ebetu (Sapporo) 747 kHz, Ogata (Akita) 774 kHz, Otsu (Kumamoto) 873 kHz) will be expired after April 1, 2026.

NHK says they will save 37 billion yen for the next 20 years by ending R2.

From May 25 to June 8, the terrorist threat level was lowered to "yellow", and from June 8, the "yellow" level was extended every 15 days, then from mid-November, every two months.

It still applies to this day as it has been renewed once again.

Almost all of the restrictions imposed during the red level transition remain in force. Specifically, critical infrastructure will continue to be closely monitored and guarded. Checkpoints to inspect vehicles are maintained at entries and exits of the area. Security forces are on maximum alert. Drone flights are prohibited without the permission of the Transnistrian Ministry of State Security.

Entrance to the center is controlled by the army. Peculiarity of the site is its fence that forms the border with Ukraine. In terms of radio activity, it is limited to the broadcasting of the national radio and broadcasts of Russian stations on medium waves.

ongoing turmoil in the country, and the unprecedented crackdown on protests. To complement the existing BBC News Persian video and digital services, the radio programme will be available on mediumwave and shortwave across Iran to increase the population's access to news and information. To broaden its offer and availability of programming, the BBC World Service has also made some of its TV content available on mediumwave radio.

Since 8 January, the Iranian people have been subject to an internet blackout. Prior to this, BBC News Persian's digital services saw their biggest reach in a year with their platforms reaching more than 33 million people. The short-term programme will cover the latest news and developments in Iran and will place events inside the country within their wider regional and international context.

Where to find the programme: The live programme will be available at 16.30 GMT/UTC (20.00 hrs Iran Time) on 702 kHz medium wave and 9770 kHz short wave. The programme will be repeated at 18.00 GMT/UTC (21.30 hrs Iran time) on 702 kHz mediumwave and 5935 kHz shortwave. A visualised version of the programme will be broadcast on BBC Persian TV at 18.00 GMT/UTC (21.30 hrs Iran time).

**RUSSIA: Mediumwave still in use.**

The RTRS Far East Regional Centre continues to operate a network of synchronised transmitters broadcasting on 756 kHz to cover the territories of Khabarovsk, Kamchatka and Chukotka with the station Vostok Rossii (Russian Far East).

This synchronised network comprises medium-wave transmitters at Berezovy 5 kW, Bikin 5 kW, Bogorodskoye 5 kW, Chegdomyn 5 kW, De Kastri 5 kW, Khabarovsk 20 kW, Komsomolsk-on-Amur 20 kW, Krasnoye 20 kW, Nikolayevsk-on-Amur 5 kW, Troitskoye 5 kW, Tsimmermanovka 5 kW, Vyazemsky 5 kW.

This is a unique example in Russia, given that all broadcasts in this band have been discontinued for budgetary reasons. There are several reasons for this exception: the region's specific characteristics, its greater autonomy from Moscow, and the desire of the Ministry of Information of the Khabarovsk Territory to reduce the influence of foreign radio stations broadcasting in Russian.

A major modernisation programme, planned for nearly ten years, has been delayed. Officials had planned to convert all medium-wave broadcasting to digital format. According to them, "this change should increase coverage of the population by 10 to 15 per cent and considerably improve broadcast quality. They hoped that with 'digitisation', the percentage of radio coverage would rise to 98 per cent".

The regional government wanted to go even further and use shortwave to cover remote areas. The system was to comprise two 50 kW transmitters capable of operating between 4.21 and 10.48 MHz. The horizontally polarised antennas will be directed towards north-eastern Russia, the Sea of Okhotsk, the Bering Strait and the Far North.

In March this year, the project was revived: specialists from the RTRS Far East Regional Centre launched a major upgrade of the broadcasting network of the Vostok Rossii radio station in Khabarovsk Krai.

The installation of new equipment has begun at broadcasting centres in Bikin, Vyazemskoye, Kotikovo and other towns in the region.

The modernisation of the network is being carried out on the initiative of the Khabarovsk Krai government and the Ministry of Digital Development and Communications.

The details of this modernisation are not known, but according to the authorities, it will significantly expand the station's coverage area and improve signal quality for residents of the region.

It is planned to commission 55 FM broadcasting stations between November 2026 and December 2027.

Will they finally digitise the medium wave band, keep it as it is, or replace it with FM? What about the shortwave project? (Radio Magazine via Facebook, March 17)

### Happy summer radio broadcasting season!

A-26 on March 29 - October 25, 2026. - In 2026, as in previous years, Russia will not change its clocks for summer or winter time. Seasonal time changes in Russia were abolished in 2014, and the country now observes permanent winter time.

Europe will switch to summer time in 2026. Most European countries will move their clocks forward one hour on Sunday, March 29, 2026.

Most countries in Asia and Africa do not use summer time (daylight saving time), especially in regions close to the equator. In countries such as China, India, Japan, Vietnam, South Korea, and most Central Asian countries, clocks remain the same year-round.

Daylight Saving Time (DST) in the United States is in effect from the second Sunday in March to the first Sunday in November. Clocks are moved forward one hour, increasing daylight hours in the evening. In 2026, the transition will begin on March 8 and end on November 1, covering almost the entire country except Arizona and Hawaii.

Following in the footsteps of RNE, **COPE** now appears to be following suit. COPE stations are repeatedly broadcasting a message announcing the end of medium-wave broadcasting.

It must be said that the decision to stop investing in this frequency band was taken years ago, and there was a policy

not to purchase spare parts.

Most of the transmitters had been built outside urban areas. Given the expansion of urban development, they now find themselves surrounded by residential areas. Developers hope to acquire these vast plots of land, provided they are not also used for FM masts.

According to the latest surveys, the audience share for medium wave is 5%. It should be noted that everything has been done in recent years to put listeners off medium wave by reducing transmission power.

COPE's policy was to shut down its transmitters one by one without giving any notice. Some of their radio stations were opposed to this, as in certain regions listenership was high due to the poor quality of FM reception.

The fact remains that COPE is switching off medium wave in Valencia, Zaragoza and other cities. In the case of Valencia, it is difficult to justify the value of the service in the event of disasters: the Valencia and Castellón transmitters are located in flood-prone areas.

It remains to be seen whether listeners will speak out in favour of keeping the medium-wave service. This is certainly an opportunity to send in a final listening report.

COPE's frequencies are: 783, 837, 882, 900, 999, 1053, 1134, 1143, 1215, 1224, 1269 and 1296 kHz.

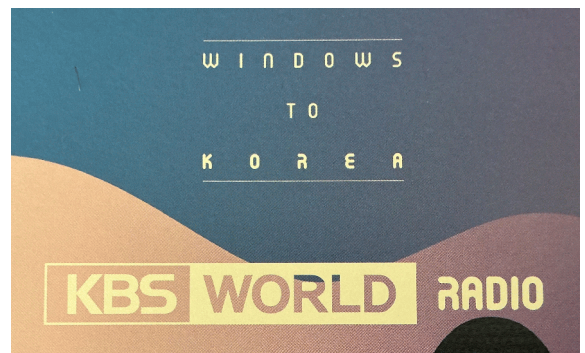
